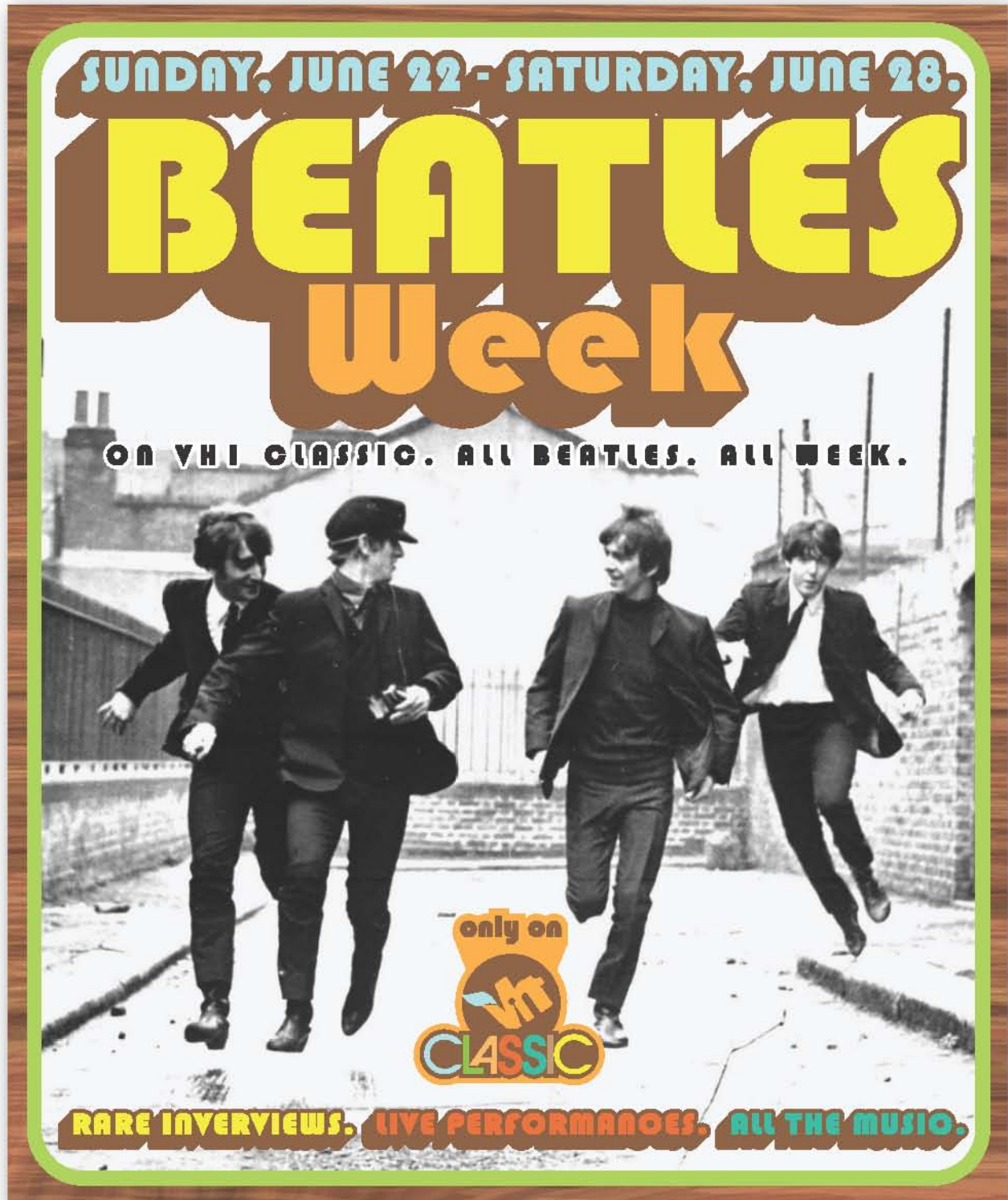

THE EVENTS

Oral Interpretation of Literature
 The goal of this event is to explore how a speaker can move an audience with emotion. Speakers are required to perform an eight to ten minute presentation of literature. Competitors stand in one spot and read from a prepared manuscript (known as a "black book").

Platform Speaking Events
 These events are what one typically thinks of when discussing public speaking. Students create and deliver an eight to ten minute speech. Winning platform events are typically about cutting edge information, technology, and social concerns.

 Michael helps with the... in addition to the After Dinner Speeches to Entertain (STE, or After Dinner Speeches) for 12 years.

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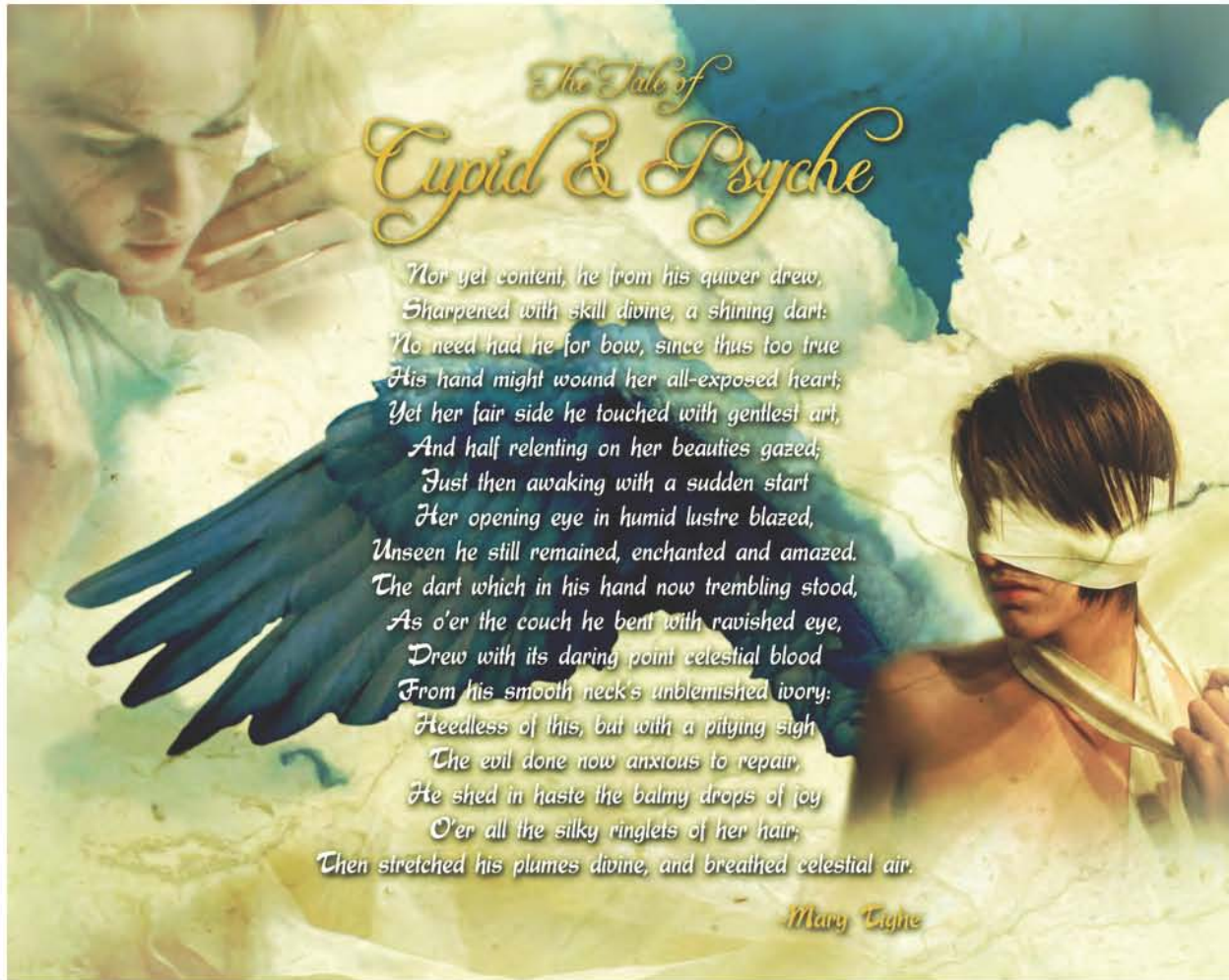

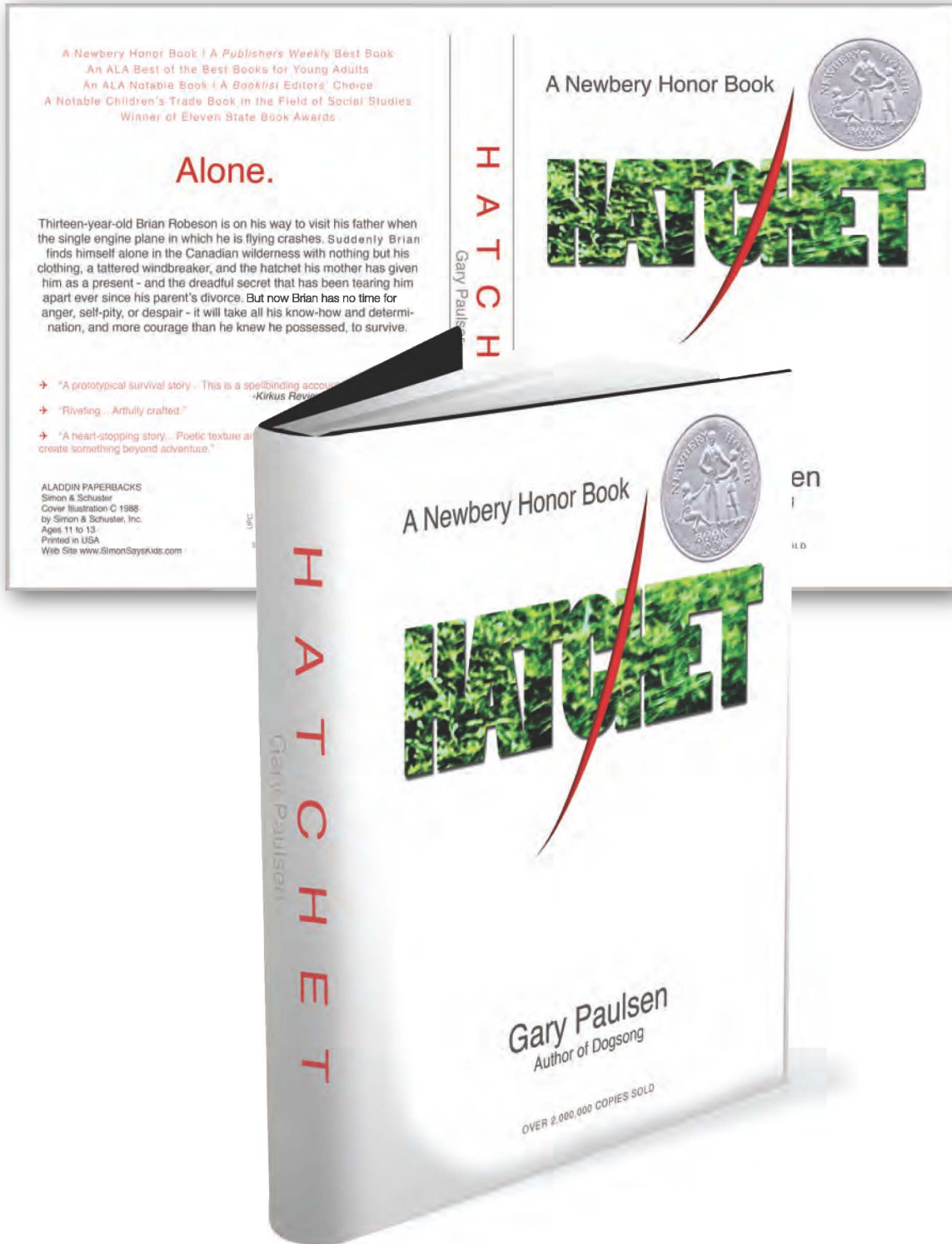

Mythology Montage

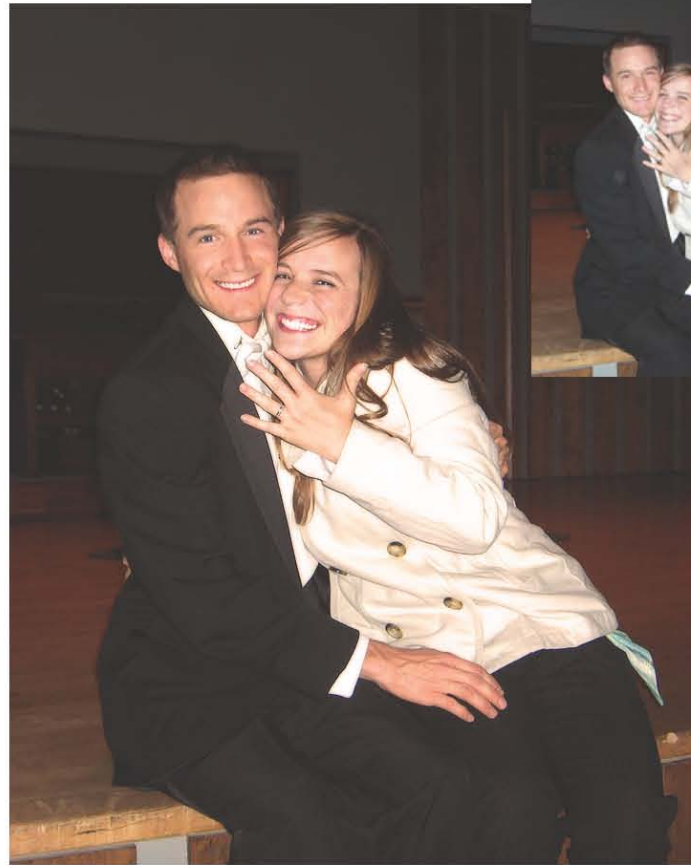
A montage representing the myth of Cupid and Psyche. Six stock images used.
